The institution's mission directs resource allocation, innovation, and continuous quality improvement through ongoing systematic planning and evaluation of programs and Services.

The institution's mission and goals are the foundation for financial planning. Financial information is disseminated to support effective planning and decision-making and provide opportunities for members of participatory governance groups to participate in the development of plans and budgets.

The Superintendent/President shall ensure that the District has and implements a broad-based, comprehensive, systematic, and integrated approach to planning that involves appropriate segments of the college community and is supported by institutional effectiveness research.

Institutional planning shall include, but is not limited to, the following:

- District Technology Plan
- Educational Vision Plan
- Equal Employment Opportunity Plan
- Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) Plan
- Facilities Vision Plan
- Strategic Plan
- Strategic Enrollment Management Plan
- Student Equity Plan

The Superintendent/President shall submit to the Board those plans for which Board approval is required by Title 5.

The Superintendent/President shall ensure all relevant stakeholders have the opportunity to contribute during the developmental and review process for



comprehensive institutional plans. The Superintendent/President shall ensure the Board is informed about the status of institutional planning.
